## Secure, broadband-based connectivity

Broadband is faster and more reliable than ever. Most retail sites either have broadband in place or can get it from a variety of carriers. With Mako, you can now use any available broadband connection to process credit card and loyalty data in a truly PCI compliant manner. You can also establish VPNs between head office and your retail locations via Mako's patented easy VPN-over-broadband communications technology.

While Mako gives you true choice over your connectivity options we also provide peace of mind, minimizing downtime over broadband using 4G/LTE cellular failover with a built-in commercial grade Sierra Wireless modem inside the Mako appliance. Mako's set-and-forget Quality of Service (QoS) policies even allow operators to prevent payments from taking a back seat to other network traffic when bandwidth is limited or while a site is operating in failover mode.

Remote-site network security and PCI compliance are at the heart of the Mako system. With Mako's pre-established PCI templates, you can extend validated PCI-compliant corporate network policy across any number of remote sites quickly and safely. Authorized

users can log in to Mako's web-based Central Management System (CMS) using secure two-factor authentication and perform diagnostics, refine system configurations or check network stats in real-time. Secure remote network management and compliance monitoring has never been easier.

The Mako System is designed specifically for the distributed enterprise, allowing retailers, franchisors and multi-site operators to have highly secure real-time remote control and command over sites in any geography worldwide.


The Mako System is more than just software. Physical separation of POS traffic is a PCI requirement, and the Mako appliance is built with PCI in mind, offering up to four physically-separated LANs within a single Mako appliance. Each LAN can be dedicated to a different part of your business—complete with the appropriate level of security.

## How it works

Payment, loyalty, back office and Wi-Fi data passes through the Internet via broadband. VPNs connect your head office to retail sites to share business info. Card data goes directly to payment processors and loyalty programs.

If the WAN goes down the Mako routes payments securely over the built-in 3G/4G LTE cellular modem until the primary connection resumes.
